

Use of Video Surveillance on School Property

The Chimacum Board of Directors authorizes the use of video cameras on school grounds and in school buses for purposes of promoting and maintaining a safe environment, protection of district property, and deterrence and prevention of criminal activity and conduct violations.

The recordings captured by such video cameras are law enforcement unit records, and will be maintained by the district's designated law enforcement unit. Videotapes will only be retained if necessary for use for law enforcement purposes, student disciplinary proceeding, or other matters as determined necessary by the administration. Parents may request to review videotapes of their child only if the videotapes are used in a disciplinary proceeding involving their child or otherwise maintained by the district as an education record for that child, subject to applicable legal requirements. Under no circumstances shall videotapes be exploited for purposes of personal gain, profit, or commercial publication, nor shall such videotapes be disclosed except as may be authorized by law.

The superintendent or designee will develop procedures to implement this policy. These procedures will include the location and monitoring of video cameras, permissible uses of videotapes, and how long videotapes shall be retained.
