

# Tuition and Fees 2023/2024

## Partnership Program

(Only applicable for pre-approved corporate partners and diplomatic missions)



**FIS** Frankfurt International School

### New Student Registration Fee ..... € 1,500

This fee ensures the processing of the application for admission of a new student or of a student returning after an absence of one year or longer. It is not refunded if the application is withdrawn and not transferable to future school years.

### Re-enrollment Fee ..... € 350

This fee secures a returning student's placement for the coming school year. Placement is conditional upon fulfillment of the provisions of re-enrollment. This fee is not refundable.

### Down Payment ..... € 2,000

In addition to the registration or re-enrollment fee, a down payment of € 2,000 is required to assure enrollment of a student and will be credited towards tuition. Only upon receipt of the applicable payment is admission/re-admission assured. It is not refunded if the student application is withdrawn and not transferable to future school years.

### Annual Capital Assessment Fee\* (payable in Year 1 and 2) ..... Year 2023/2024: € 6,150

An annual capital assessment fee is payable in the first and in the second year for new students as of Pre-Primary. For school year 2023/2024 the capital assessment fee payable is € 6,150. This fee is assigned to a fund specifically designed for capital investments. It is not refundable. For students returning after an absence of one year or longer, all prior payments are credited to this total. Departing students who have attended the school 65 days or less in the school year of their departure pay only half the capital fee in that year.

### Other Costs

**First Language** or **Identity Language** fees are invoiced for students who participate in a first language or identity language program. Currently FL is offered for Dutch, Japanese, Korean and annual fees range from € 1,200 to € 2,330 depending on age group and course frequency.

If a student requires **Learning Support** beyond the school's normal provision of services, additional fees may be required. These fees can be provided by the Admissions or Business Office, or the division counselor.

During the school year, **additional expenditures** may be incurred (e.g. trip fees, Grade 11,12 IB fees, math calculators, optional lunch, after-school activities). Students in Grades 5 and above must come to school with a personal laptop computer. Grade level trips (Grades 5–11) are included in the tuition fees as an integral part of the educational program.

### Payments

Re-enrollment fee and down payment for returning students are due **by 14 April 2023**. Tuition and transportation fees for the school year as well as the Capital Assessment Fee are payable in advance, at the latest **by 1 July 2023**. For students who start during the school year payments are due as per the communicated invoice due date. Past due accounts are charged with a late payment fee of 1% after this date to cover administration / handling costs. Money transfers in Euro can be made to the following banks:

## Pro-ration

The annual tuition and transportation fee is pro-rated for students who leave early or enroll late, always based on the official leaving or acceptance date of the respective school day. The leaving date (ie. last school day) needs to be communicated to the school in writing minimum two weeks in advance.

## Leave of Absence

In order to guarantee re-admission after a leave of absence, families have the choice to reserve a space at FIS upon return by paying 50% of the respective tuition fee for the period of absence.

## Information for German Tax Payers

For children in Grades 1–12: 30% of fees (tuition, registration / re-enrollment fee), up to a maximum of € 5,000 per child, are tax-deductible. For children in First Steps, Pre-Primary, Primary: 2/3 of the child-care costs, up to a maximum of € 4,000 per child, are tax-deductible. Benefits reimbursed to you or paid on your behalf by your employer are normally treated as taxable income (*geldwerter Vorteil*). Under certain conditions, fees for pre-school children are exempted. ## Transportation System

Our school bus system offers 35 routes at Oberursel and ten routes at Wiesbaden. Bus rides are generally no longer than one hour and bus stops are easily accessible. Bus rules and bad weather guidelines help to make the system run smoothly. The school reserves the right to alter routes, times or fees after due notice has been given to parents. Fees are based on travel distance. Children up to Grade 2 may request one-way bus service at half cost.

Flexible bus tickets for those not using our bus offering regularly may be purchased for € 8 per ride, based on availability and only for a limited number of occasions. They are available either at the Business Office, the Primary School or the Transportation Office.
