- **How clean are we 182 responses, 77.5% felt we are clean**
- **Bullying is NOT an issue, 30% felt it was a 5.**

- **Mr. Belton reported about having a conversation and what a phenomenal job on handling the issue.**
- **Mrs. Robbins reported about having a conversation with her daughter.**
- **Mrs. Shrader talked about having this conversation in CReW about bullying and how it still happens.**

Student Survey:

- I know adults in the building, 33.3% rated 5
- Feel safe at CRHS, 41.8% rated 5
- CRHS is very clean, 51.4% rated 5
- Bullying is not an issue, 27.8% rated 5
- CREW is valuable, Dr. McQuay elaborated on what it is and how it is broken down
- FLEX do students utilize it every week, 28.7% rated 5
- I have enough time to see my teachers with current set up, 34.8% rated 5
