4.0 credits of English

(27 Credit Diploma)

Important Notes

- 4 years of math is strongly recommended for collegebound students.
- There is no foreign language requirement to graduate.
- 16 Core Credits required for NCAA qualification (student athletes).
- Students taking Seminary can earn 7.0 credits a year (7x4= 28 credits).
Without Seminary students can earn 8.0 credits a year (8x4= 32 credits).



❖ Developing a 4-Year Plan

4-Year Plan Instructions:

1. Log into MYDSD
2. Find the ACADEMICS tab and then CCR 4 Year Plan
3. Fill out the College Plan page and then click "next"
4. Fill out the Graduation Plan:
 - a. Click on each subject for the drop-down menu with classes
 - b. Choose classes that you may be interested in and that can help prepare you for your future career. Make sure that the classes you choose will also fulfill your graduation requirements.
 - c. Try to choose classes for all 4 years.
5. If there is an exclamation point by a class, it means that you have not entered the class yet or fulfilled the graduation requirement.

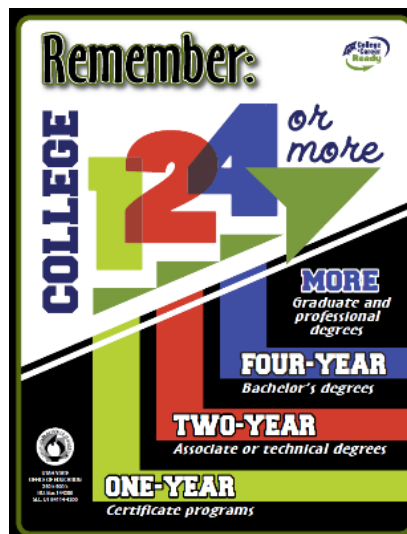
