Business Items

- The Board of Directors motioned to approve the contract offer for hiring Travis W. Hanson as its next superintendent. The motion carried unanimously.
- Chief Financial Officer Heather Ellingson presented Resolution 23-01 2023-24 Financial Emergency and Budget Uncertainty, which allows the Superintendent to develop and recommend to the Board a modified education program designed to address expected budget shortfalls through reduction in expenses. The Board approved the resolution unanimously.
- Director of Secondary Education Darren Nelson presented a student travel proposal on behalf of MHS and MSHS DECA to compete at the National DECA Competition in Orlando, Fla., April 20-26. The Board approved the proposal unanimously.

District Reports

- Chief Financial Officer Heather Ellingson presented the financial report for the month of February 2023. This report covered enrollment numbers, General Fund balances and projections for future financial considerations.
- Assistant Superintendent Jared Hoadley presented an update to the Board about Technology usage in the Mead School District. The presentation outlined the District's use of chromebooks, issues that have been brought forward with web use by parents and staff, and plans to remedy parent and staff concerns through tightening of web surfing capabilities, application/software usage and content filtering.
