

NURSERY FEES 2023 - 2024

Three terms a year beginning in September, January and April

STONAR NURSERY APPLICATIONS

- Non-refundable application fee - £100
- Acceptance Fee - £200, payable on acceptance of a place, refundable on leaving.

Stonar Nursery is term time only from the age of two, with Holiday Club provision outside of term time for 3-11 year olds. The minimum number of sessions is four mornings per week or three day sessions. Fewer sessions may be considered at the discretion of the Nursery Manager.

EARLY YEARS FUNDING SCHEME

Stonar is a registered provider of the Early Years Funding Scheme. Parents are able to use universal funding of 15 hours per week, and those who are eligible are able to use their extended entitlement of up to 30 hours per week subject to a maximum of 38 weeks as per HMRC guidance. Funding can be used for morning and day sessions during term-time and some holiday club weeks.

FURTHER DETAILS

<p>Nursery After School Care (3 and over)</p>	<p>After-school care is provided from 3.30pm – 6.00pm in the Prep School. Children requiring this service must book in advance. The fee for this service will be charged irrespective of whether the whole session has been used.</p>
<p>Attendance</p>	<p>The minimum number of sessions is four mornings per week or three day sessions. Fewer sessions may be considered at the discretion of the Nursery Manager. Parents are asked to sign and complete a session request form prior to the start of each term. If you wish to seek advice on the most appropriate session combination for your child please speak to the Nursery Manager.</p>
<p>Payment of Fees</p>	<p>Fees are invoiced on a termly basis and payment must be received two weeks before the first day of term. Interest may be charged on overdue accounts in line with the schools terms and conditions. Fees are reviewed annually and parents will be advised during the spring term of any changes for the following academic year. Parents remain liable to pay full Stonar Nursery fees if they become ineligible for EYFS funding.</p>
<p>Late Collection Charges</p>	<p>Parents are charged extra for late collection as follows: Late collection (up to 15 minutes) no charge Late collection (15-30 minutes) £10 Late collection (30+ minutes) full session charge of the following session</p> <p>Please note that collections after 6pm are not possible except in emergencies and a charge of £20 will be made for any collections after the usual closing time. Parents/carers will be informed at the time if late collection charges have been incurred.</p>
<p>Notice to change or withdraw sessions</p>	<p>We require a term's notice in writing for a child leaving or reducing their booked sessions, otherwise payment of the appropriate term's fees in lieu of notice will be payable. Please inform the Nursery Manager in writing if you wish to withdraw your child, or reduce their sessions. Increases in regular sessions are subject to availability and the approval of the Nursery Manager. Sessions not attended will still be charged. Additional sessions may be booked spontaneously, subject to availability. Sessions cannot be swapped to take account of public holidays or personal circumstances in any given week. EYFS funding is claimed based on the sessions booked prior to the start of each term in line with Wiltshire Council's funding policy, therefore additional sessions arranged after term commences will not qualify for EYFS funding until the subsequent term.</p>
<p>Holiday Club</p>	<p>Stonar operates a Holiday Club for children aged 3 to 11. The Holiday Club is open during school holidays with the exception of the Christmas-New Year closure. Holiday Club runs from 8.00am – 5.00pm. Booking is required in advance via the school website. Please see our website for dates of the next sessions and booking forms.</p>
<p>Extras</p>	<p>At Stonar we are committed to providing a quality Nursery provision for your child. We offer a number of activities and experiences beyond a standard Nursery provision, making use of the specialist facilities and experienced teachers available at the School. The activities typically include Forest School, Swimming lessons, Dance, Nature walks, Cooking, and Outings and a Service Charge of £5 per session covers everything we offer that goes above and beyond the EYFS curriculum.</p> <p>Parents will be notified in advance of any additional activities which will incur a charge, e.g. Nursery trips.</p>
