- Leslie Bertram welcomed everyone to the Community Council meeting today.

## School Improvement Plan 2023-2024

- An electric copy of the School Improvement Plan was sent via email to members of the Community Council.
- The first few pages of the plan discuss the school.
- It discusses last year's goals and which goals we met and the ones that we did not. It also explains why we did not meet the goals.
  - Teachers were asked what they would like to have. Teachers said they would like to have aides.
- Areas of Improvement:
  - Curriculum Goals #1: Increased Reading Proficiency
    - Grades k-6, 65% of students will meet the goal of typical or above growth by EOY 2024 as indicated by Acadience Reading Pathways of Progress.
      - We will employ 2 Aides to assist with SIPPS and progress monitoring.
        - Teachers will meet regularly in PLCs to discuss and use data to inform and plan interventions.
          - Next year we will be a Hub school for ASC classes.
        - Schools Cubed to implement recommended science of reading.
    - Curriculum Goals #2: Mathematics
      - We will increase the end of year percentages of students in grades 3-6 by 3% according to RISE math scores compared to prior 2023-year data.
        - Employ and retain Math academic teacher assistant
        - Math Facts Intervention program will be used by teachers and teacher assistants.
        - Teachers will meet in regularly scheduled PLCs to discuss math data and plan instructions and interventions.
    - School Trust Funds:
      - Projected 23-24 budget: \$45,226.37
      - 2 Language Art Aides: 36,000.00
      - Math Aides: 8,400.00
      - We will hire additional aides to help with progress monitoring
    - TSSA (Not Trust Lands)
      - Just FYI, TSSA does not require approval by community council, but we wanted to share our projections.
      - Online Software/subscriptions: \$20,000
      - Artist in Residence: (BTS) \$10,000

- Meet the Masters: \$10,000 (Mary Booth)
  - Student support Aide (Behavior)
- **Leslie Bertram called for a vote: Motion passed unanimously.**
  - 2023-2024 School Improvement plan has been approved. The district will look it over to make sure that everything is okay with the plan.
