Next Step: Preparation for Road Test

Make an appointment. The exam stations are typically booking out a good two months. You can schedule a road test at dvs.dps.mn.gov or call 651-201-7900 for Metro Area Exam Stations. You will need your permit number and birth date.

Bring:

- Valid Learner's Permit to give to examiner
- A vehicle in safe working condition.
- Current proof of insurance for the vehicle.
- Money (check, money order, or cash. No credit/debit cards accepted.)
- Supervised Driving Log (and Point of Impact Certificate of Completion if applicable).

If under 18 years of age:

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Have Certificate of Completion (white card) proving you completed behind the wheel.
- Must have held a Learner's Permit for the last six months without a conviction for a moving violation or an alcohol or controlled substance violation.
- Bring parent, county appointed guardian, foster parent or director of transitional living program to sign and approve application. Must certify you have driven for the required number of hours.
