Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s)

Barstow Unified School District works hard to be "Your Best Choice for Academic Success"; and one of the options available to families is an intradistrict open enrollment/intradistrict transfer (IDT) request.

An intradistrict open enrollment/intradistrict transfer (IDT) is when parents/guardians want to enroll their student(s) at a school other than the designated school in their area of residency. California Education Code Section 35160.5(b) permits parents to indicate a preference for the school which their child will attend, regardless of the child's place of residence within the district and requires the district to honor this parental preference if the school has sufficient capacity without displacing other currently enrolled students.

If your child currently attends one of our six location-based elementary schools, you may request a transfer for the 2023/2024 school year to one of the other elementary schools for TK-5th grade during the **open enrollment period from April 15, 2023-June 1, 2023** by completing the attached form and **returning it on or before June 1, 2023** to the school district's Central Enrollment Center or to your local school office.

On or before August 21, 2023, after the first two weeks of the start of the 23/24 school year, the District will notify you of the status of your request (whether approved, denied, or on a waiting list); and if approved, you will be able to enroll your child in the new school at that time. If your child is currently on an IDT, they will continue at their current school without the need for submitting a new application.

Please be advised the district does not provide transportation for intradistrict transfer students. The parents are responsible for providing transportation to and from school.

Additionally, Barstow Unified School District also offers two district-wide parent-choice schools, Barstow Fine Arts Academy and Barstow STEM Academy. These schools are not part of the intradistrict transfer open enrollment period. Information regarding these schools, including applications for enrollment, can be found on our district website or at http://barstow.schoolmint.net. Please note if these schools are already full, you will be added to the waitlist and notified.

REQUEST FOR INTRADISTRICT TRANSFER UNDER OPEN ENROLLMENT POLICY

Open Enrollment/ Intradistrict Transfer:

- 1. Applications for Intradistrict transfers will be received during the Open Enrollment Period.
- 2. Applications are available at the BUSD District Office Central Enrollment Center, the Pupil Services Department, and online at http://barstow.schoolmint.net.
- 3. The period of Open Enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year will close on June 1, 2023.
- 4. You will be notified in writing of whether or not your child is accepted, denied, or placed on a waiting list on or before the end of the 2nd week of school, week of August 21, 2023. Please keep in mind that before approving or denying an IDT request, the District takes the following into consideration: Enrollment during the first two weeks of school at the school site to determine if there is space in the requested grade level.
- 5. If the school you have requested to transfer to does not have the capacity to accept a transfer, an alternative school will be offered.
- 6. You will have 10 days from notification that your child has been approved to notify the school district's Central Enrollment Center of whether or not your child will be accepting the opportunity to transfer.
- 7. Failure to notify the school district that you accept the opportunity will result in your space being given to a student on the waiting list.
- 8. District transportation is not provided for any intra-district transfer attendance agreements.
- 9. Openings will be filled based on the priority list below:
 - a. Is enrolled in a district school designated by the California Department of Education (CDE) as "persistently dangerous" (20 USC 7912; 5 CCR 11992)
 - b. Is a victim of a violent crime while on school grounds (20 USC 7912)
 - c. Is a victim of an act of bullying committed by another district student, as determined through an investigation following the parent/guardian's submission of a written complaint with the school, district, or local law enforcement agency pursuant to Education Code 234.1 (Education Code 46600)
 - d. Is currently enrolled in a district school identified by CDE for comprehensive support and improvement, with priority given to the lowest academically achieving students from low-income families as determined pursuant to 20 USC 6313(a)(3) (20 USC 6311)
 - e. Is experiencing special circumstances that might be harmful or dangerous to the student in the current attendance area, including, but not limited to, threats of bodily harm or threats to the emotional stability of the student. Any such student may transfer to a district school that is at capacity and otherwise closed to transfers. To grant priority under these circumstances, the Superintendent or designee must have received either a written statement from a representative of an appropriate state or local agency, including, but not necessarily limited to, a law enforcement official or a social worker, or a properly licensed or registered professional, including, but not necessarily limited to,
 - i. psychiatrist, psychologist, marriage and family therapist, clinical social worker, or professional clinical counselor
 - ii. A court order, including a temporary restraining order and injunction

(Education Code 35160.5)

- f. Is a sibling of another student already attending that school
- g. Has a parent/guardian whose primary place of employment is that school
- h. Has requested enrollment in another school but does not meet the reasons in a-g.
- 10. Requests for transfer for items 5a 5f may be submitted outside the open enrollment period. Choice of school is still subject to space availability, except as otherwise required by law.
