# Timelines and Deadlines

- May 1 – Final date to purchase Cap/Gown

# To receive a High School Diploma you need:

Minimum 2.0 GPA

PASS all of your required courses (don't fail any courses this semester!)

**MAY 8** - Take the required EOC tests for your classes

(Algebra, Geometry, Biology, US History)  
If the course, or any part of the course was taken this school year – EOC required!

Pass the Alg 1 \ Geo EOC/FSA Reading test  
(or concordant score)

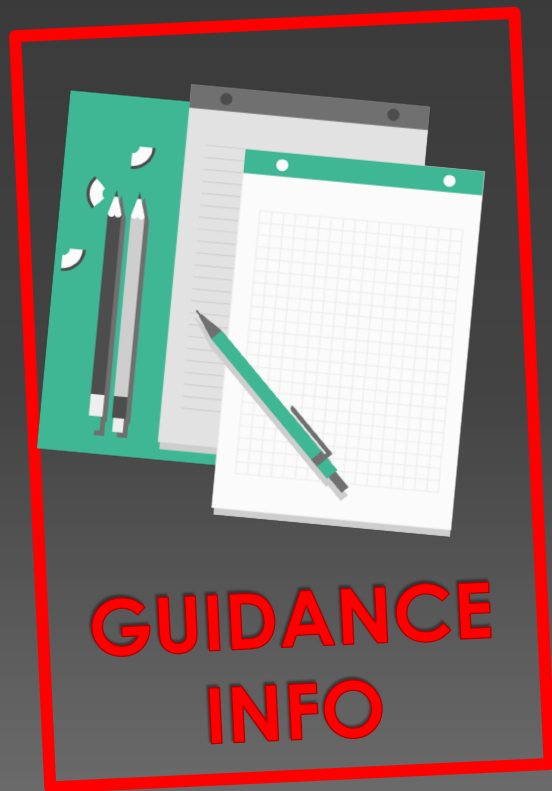
# High School Diploma (continued)

- If you pass all of the courses required for graduation, but do not have a 2.0 GPA or did not pass the FSA Reading or Algebra 1 EOC (receive the concordant score):
  - > You will receive a certificate of completion, in lieu of a high school diploma
  - > We encourage you to return and take FSA/Algebra EOC the test next year or take the SAT/ACT
  - > You can still walk for graduation (If you had taken (attended) each of the required EOC tests.

# If you have taken an EOC course this year (or part)

- You will be permitted to walk in the ceremony if you sit for the tests, but will not receive a diploma until the test results return in July
- Will not have an official transcript ready until all test scores are received

July test dates are available for any senior, but you will not walk if you wait or do not attend May test date. (late graduation July)

- Emergency- contact Ms. LaGrotta ASAP



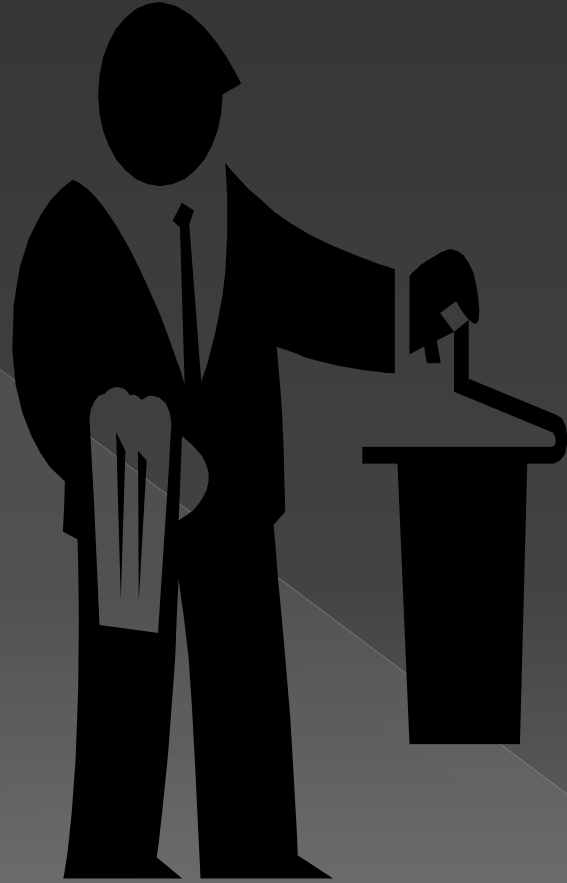
# Graduation Ceremony

# Dress Code for Graduation

- ◉ White Collared Shirt
- ◉ Tie
- ◉ A place to store your cell phone - pocket
- ◉ Dark Pants
- ◉ Dark Shoes – no flip flops
- ◉ Nothing added to your cap and gown



# Dress code for Graduation

- ◉ Dresses/Skirts that do not fall below your gown
- ◉ Cell phones need a place to store - pocket
- ◉ Shoes – **no flip flops** (**practice walking**)
- ◉ Nothing added to your cap and gown
- ◉ Purses – please do not bring with you

# Ocean Center Bag Policy

- Each ticket holder, including children, may carry an approved **clear bag** and a clutch purse:
  - One clear bag no larger than 12"x6"x12" or a one-gallon clear Ziploc, or similar, bag
  - One small clutch bag or purse no larger than 6.5"x6.5", with or without a strap
- Diapers and wipes may be carried in a clear bag; however, diaper bags are not permitted.
- Additional clothing, blankets, etc. are permitted if carried loosely (preferably over the shoulder to be screened more quickly) or in an approved clear bag.
- Small cameras, binoculars, and cell phones may be carried loosely or in an approved clear bag

- *Yearbooks for \$95 (cash only).*

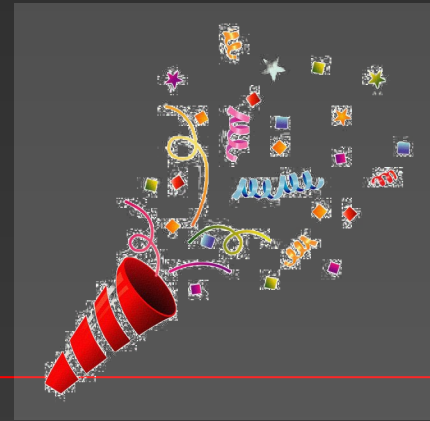
