Family Literacy

AGES BIRTH TO 5 (BEFORE KINDERGARTEN)

This multi-age class meets two days per week and is for families wanting to practice English. Parents and children attend together to improve their English language skills through conversation, learning activities, music, and more. An English/ESL teacher and an ECFE teacher teach the class together.

Help Me Grow

Early Childhood Information & Referral

Connecting families to early intervention services. Some children need extra help to learn and grow. Help Me Grow is a Minnesota state initiative that connects children with developmental delays and disabilities and their families to free, local early intervention services.

If you have a concern about a child's development, you can refer the child through Help Me Grow for a free screening or evaluation. Services are free to eligible children ages birth-5, regardless of income or immigrant status.

Help Me Grow's website, helpmegrowmn.org, offers valuable information to help parents and caregivers understand a child's development. Resources include developmental milestones, strategies to encourage development and information about referrals.

ECFE Classes

ECFE Classes include Three Components:

Parent-Child Interaction

You and your child spend time together enjoying activities designed to enhance learning. You will leave with new ideas for things to do together at home.

Parent Education

Meet with other parents and a licensed ECFE teacher to discuss topics such as development, temperament, discipline, and getting ready for school. The parenting group time takes place in a separate room or in a designated area of the children's classroom for non-separating classes.

Children's Classroom

While parents participate in parent education, children learn through play in a classroom with early childhood staff. Children will enjoy music, art, stories, large and small motor activities as they interact with other children.





Infants

AGES BIRTH - 12 MONTHS

This class includes activities, songs, rhymes, movement, and parent discussion with a trained parent educator. You and your child will spend time together exploring toys and participating in classroom activities in a stimulating environment.

Parent-Child Playschool

AGES 2-3 BY SEPT 1, 2023

Playschool is an opportunity for children to become more comfortable and confident in a classroom setting, learn to follow rules, routines and directions, begin to initiate social interactions, and become an integral part of a group.

In the fall, children come to school with a parent/guardian and spend time in a traditional ECFE classroom gaining these skills and separating during parent time one day a week on Mondays. Starting on November 14, 2023, we will implement the second day as child-only. Children may attend the second day, Tuesday, as soon as they are 2.5 years old.

Cancellations

We reserve the right to cancel classes due to insufficient enrollment. Fees paid will be refunded. Refunds will not be issued for classes missed or after a class has started.

Determine Payment Due

Use the class fee schedule on the back cover to determine fee for the first child attending the class. Add half of the fee for each additional child from the same family attending the same class.

Payments

All one-time payments are due at the time of registration. Payments for full year classes will be split into three equal payments. The first payment will be due at the time of registration and the second and third payments will occur in November and February. No family will be denied participation due to inability to pay. If you need help with payments call 651-653-3100.

Refund Policy

Refunds will be issued when requested at least five working days prior to the class starting date. A \$10 service charge will be deducted from each refund processed.

Immunization Records

Immunization records MUST accompany the registration if your child is participating in an ECFE class. Class registrations will not be processed without an up-to-date immunization record each school year. Immunization records can be faxed directly from your clinic to 651-653-3155.







JOIN OUR PAC!

What is the Parent Advisory Council (PAC)?

Every Early Childhood program is required to have an advisory council that assists in the developing, planning and monitoring of the ECFE program. The PAC consists of parents participating in the program, local community professionals, and agency representatives who can offer input and guidance on community needs.

- The PAC meets 3 times per year (Sept, Jan and Apr). Childcare provided at meetings.
- The PAC runs 3 special events per year (fall, winter, spring).
- The PAC helps to approve special grants for the program.
- The PAC supports 2 fundraisers per year.
