
Mahalo to Mr. Foster and Mrs. Miguel for leading our HFCA Keiki Choir, the students who represented us so well, and the many parents who came to watch!


## Class Spotlight: 6th Grade

Our 6th grade Life Science class recently worked in groups to create models of the human body to illustrate the different organ systems and presented their projects to our 3rd-graders to demonstrate how the organ systems function to serve the cells in our body. The 6th-graders had many aha moments, and were especially excited to learn our circulatory system is an astonishing 60,000 miles long and our heart pumps a total of 5 tablespoons per beat! They also discussed the importance of healthy eating and exercise as preventative ways to take care of their health.
