Dear Seniors and Parents:

As the Class of 2023's time in Hampton High School quickly comes to end, we want to provide you with information on important events to help you plan.

Schedule Changes and Finals Information

Prom—May 5 On May 5th, all high school students have a half day of school, which will only include periods 1-4. Any student who is attending prom must be in attendance until 11:16 AM. **There will be no approved early dismissals for students attending prom—please schedule all appointments accordingly.** Lunch will not be served on May 5th because of the early dismissal; however, bus transportation home will be available.

Keystone Exams—May 16-19: Underclassmen are taking the Keystone Exams May 16-19. **Seniors who are able to provide their own transportation may operate on a two-hour delay.** Students who utilize District transportation on those days will be placed in an academic study hall from 8:20-10:20.

Senior Finals—May 30-31: Seniors will return their books, satisfy obligations, and complete their finals on Tuesday, May 30th and Wednesday, May 31st. May 30th and 31st are attendance days for seniors. Senior who needs to make-up a final or satisfy an obligation may do so on Thursday, June 1 by scheduling an appointment with their teacher(s).

Senior Celebrations

Senior Dinner Dance—June 2: All seniors are invited to attend the senior dinner dance, which is held at the Doubletree by Hilton in Mars. Tickets for this event cost **\$50** and are on sale in the cafeteria during all lunch periods April 24-28. Please make checks payable to HTSD.

Indoor Graduation Practice & Senior Picnic—June 2: Seniors should arrive at the high school on June 2 at 10:30 AM using the pool entrance for a short indoor graduation practice in the main gym. Following the practice, all seniors are invited to attend a PTO and Student Council sponsored class picnic in the Hampton Community Park. Indoor graduation practice is considered a school attendance day.

Senior Trip to Cedar Point—June 5: The senior class trip to Cedar Point is on Monday, June 5. All interested students can purchase a ticket for during all lunch periods in the cafeteria April 24-28. The ticket cost of **\$105** covers park admission, transportation, and an all-day drink band. Please make checks payable to HTSD.

Commencement

Graduation Speeches: The opportunity to deliver a graduation speech will be awarded to two students in the senior class. The deadline to turn in the graduation speech is Thursday, May 18th at 3:15 PM. Interested students should join the Google Classroom where information is located using the join code **u4ibp4i**.

Graduation Program and Map: Students who would like their future plans shared in the graduation program and on the senior map displayed in the main hallway of the high school need to complete the following form using their school Google account before May 18th at 3:15 PM: <https://forms.gle/7CEPNqwfffP6rNHq8>

Submissions after these dates are not guaranteed to make it into the graduation program.

MANDATORY Outdoor Graduation Practice—June 6: Attendance at graduation practice on **Tuesday, June 6 from 9:00 until 11:00AM is *mandatory*** for all students planning to participate in the commencement ceremony.

Students will receive their caps, gowns, and 2 indoor ceremony tickets at practice.

If a student does not show up and participate in the entire practice, he/she may not be permitted to walk at commencement. Graduation practice is considered a school attendance day and students should not make any other plans during that time.

If the weather is inclement on June 6th, there is a mandatory graduation practice rain-date of Wednesday, June 7th. Students should not schedule appointments or work between the hours of 9 am and 11 am on June 6th **or** June 7th.

Commencement Ceremony—June 8: Family and friends are invited to attend the graduation ceremony at Fridley Field on Thursday, June 8 at 6:00 PM (tickets are not needed for a stadium graduation).

Graduates should arrive at Fridley Field at 5:00 PM wearing their cap and gown.

In case of inclement weather, check the Hampton Township School District website (www.ht-sd.org) for any change in the ceremony by early afternoon on the day of commencement. If the ceremony is changed due to inclement weather, the ceremony will be held on Friday, June 9, at 6:00 PM at Fridley Field. Should the weather remain inclement at that time, the ceremony will be postponed until Saturday, June 10 at 10:00 AM. If the weather is still not satisfactory for an outdoor ceremony at that time, the ceremony will then be held at noon at Fridley Field. Should weather remain unsatisfactory at that time, the ceremony will be at 6:00 PM. rain or shine. If the weather is satisfactory, the ceremony will be at Fridley Field. If it is not, the ceremony will be in the High School auditorium and students will be limited to two ticketed guests.
