Counselor's Corner:

Hi families! I wanted to share some tips this month for how to make homework time a more enjoyable experience. The following strategies are important to help make this time a smoother process:

• Set a specific time and place to do homework.

- Help your child stay organized.
- Model a positive attitude about school work.
- Collaborate with your child's teacher.
- Offer short breaks if necessary.
- Do something fun after homework is done.
- Check in with your child about how he/she is doing.

• Teach your child ways to cope with frustrations.

As with anything else. communication and collaboration are key. Talk with your child about what went well and what could be done to make the time better. Thankfully, homework time doesn't have to be a struggle. My hope is that these tips will help you and your children have а more pleasant homework experience!

March 28 and 29
April 4 and 5
April 18 and 19
April 20 and 21
April 27 and 28

Language Arts – Grade 3 and 6 Language Arts – Grades 4 and 5 Math – Grades 3 and 6 Math– Grades 4 and 5 Science – Grade 5

Encourage your child to take the time to read directions carefully, look back into the selection/question for answers or data, and always review the test to make sure every item is answered (proofread). Ask that your child try to do his/her best! Encourage your child to maintain a positive attitude.

Please make sure your child is at school on time. Try not to schedule any doctor, dentist or any other appointments on test mornings.

It is especially important for your child to have a good night's sleep <u>and</u> a good breakfast the morning of the test.
