

BOND 2023 ELECTION

EANES INNOVATIVE SCHOOL DISTRICT

Westlake High School



Following recommendations of the District's Bond Advisory Committee, the Eanes ISD Board of Trustees has called a May 6 bond election for voters to consider maintenance and efficiency projects, including safety and security upgrades, maintenance and refurbishment projects, and the purchase of new technological devices for students and staff.

THE BOND ELECTION WILL HAVE NO IMPACT ON THE EANES ISD TAX RATE, REGARDLESS OF THE OUTCOME. EANES ISD VOTERS WILL CONSIDER THREE PROPOSITIONS:

In addition to the work proposed across the district, the following projects are specific to Westlake High School:



WESTLAKE HIGH SCHOOL

- Access control and exterior door prop alarm safety upgrades
- Door-locking device safety upgrades
- Front entry vestibule reconfiguration
- Storefront entry system replacements
- Safety signage (wayfinding)
- LED pole lighting replacement/installation for baseball, softball, tennis, and practice fields
- Artificial turf replacement at practice fields and baseball infield
- Exterior notification safety system upgrades
- Facility refurbishments including flooring, wall finishes, ceilings, etc.
- HVAC equipment replacements
- Roofing replacements (partial)
- Tennis court resurfacing
- Fine arts equipment and uniform replacements
- Athletic equipment and uniform replacements
- Baseball and softball indoor batting cage conversion
- Softball press box conversion
- Renovations and improvements to performance arts facilities, including production lighting and technology, additional storage and the renovation of interior space to create a Technical Entertainment Crew control room
- Refurbishments at Chaparral Stadium including LED pole lighting replacement/installation, track surface replacement, bleachers, handrails and video board replacement (Prop B)
- Classroom audio replacements
- Classroom furniture replacements
- Science equipment replacements
- Replace competition gym divider
- Parking lot pavement repairs and re-striping
- Renovate existing administrative building for TLC purposes
- Renovate existing TLC for CERT/HOSA, etc
- Renovate WHS CERT/HOSA classrooms

PROPOSITION



Proposition A (\$117.773 million) would authorize safety and security upgrades, physical repairs and refurbishments at every campus — as well as energy-efficiency projects, network replacements, new learning management systems, library modernization and more.

PROPOSITION



Proposition B (\$2.411 million) would authorize refurbishments at Chaparral Stadium including pole lighting replacements, track surface replacement, bleachers, handrails and video board replacement.

PROPOSITION



Proposition C (\$11.245 million) would authorize replacement of student and staff digital devices, as well as devices in labs, classrooms and offices.
