One memory I have of my childhood was going to yearly checkups and inevitably being asked to stand against the wall with my back touching the cold metal as the nurse would look at the top of my head for a measure and every fiber of my being stretching as if to be sure that I was as tall as I could be. Perhaps you have a similar memory or story about getting your height marked as you grew. This week we finished our Winter FAST testing and the parallel to gauging academic growth is not too different than measuring height. Please know that we use these tests to routinely monitor and adjust student support so each learner is growing! School staff will utilize the data from these tests to continue to provide support to our students.

It comes as no surprise that Minnesota is cold this time of year. It is easy to assume that we have less access or opportunity to environmental based lessons, but in actual reality they are only presented differently and we often need to be intentional to seek them out. I would encourage you to have conversations as you experience your weekend about anything they might encounter from formations of ice, weight of snow on a structure, or what might be happening underneath all the snow,etc.






EVERY MEAL SIGN UP


