
I am hoping that each of you has had a chance to remove all the snow from the week and get back to normal. I appreciate your extra efforts as parents this week to help your child navigate e-learning and all of the weather related changes in routine. I want to make a point to thank our buildings and grounds crew for their diligent work with the challenging weather to help make sure that our sidewalks, parking lots, steps, and paths are as clear as possible. In addition, a special thanks to our many bus and van drivers who work so hard to get students to school safely and in a timely manner. Also, please know that our Choir concert was postponed yesterday due to the weather and will be moved to Tuesday, February 28th. Fifth and Sixth Grade Choirs perform at 6pm and Seventh and Eighth grade perform at 7pm. The event will be at the RHS Auditorium and is open to the public!

I want to make you aware that by Friday, March 3rd, each grade level will be doing one lesson during Boost (35 minutes) per week to teach social-emotional skills to our students. At the middle school, we will be using lessons through a company called Character Strong who specializes in relevant lessons appropriate for each grade that help build skills around the areas of self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship building skills, and responsible decision making. These lessons will meet SEL benchmarks as laid out by the Minnesota Department of Education. Each grade will have a slightly different plan of how and when to teach this lesson, but it will happen during the boost time frame. If you have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to contact me.

We are blessed to have effective student and staff leadership in this building. This week I was able to meet with my staff Building Leadership Team as well as three different student leadership teams including Student Council, Culture of Kindness Group and Safety Team. Each of these leadership groups brings creative ideas to help us continue to grow as a building in ensuring that we have a safe and secure learning environment, that we intentionally continue to focus on building a positive school culture, and that our programming for students is rigorous and relevant.
