



High School Diploma

- ☐ Enrollment Requirements:

 Minimum of 80 credits already completed
- ☐ Graduation Requirements: 180 credits
- Self-Paced Course Work Online - Computer Based



High School Diploma Credit Requirements

The following credits in each subject are required for a high school diploma:

National External Diploma Program (NEDP)

Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA)

- 12 week program
- Covers patient care skills and long term care facilities
- Registration information posted June 2021
- Fee: \$700 (includes textbooks)
- High school diploma required
- Students provide their own uniforms, physical, and labs

Vocational Nursing

- 18 month program
- Prepares for the NCLEX-PN State of California exam
- Classroom academics and clinical
- Registration information posted August 2021
- Fee: \$3,900
