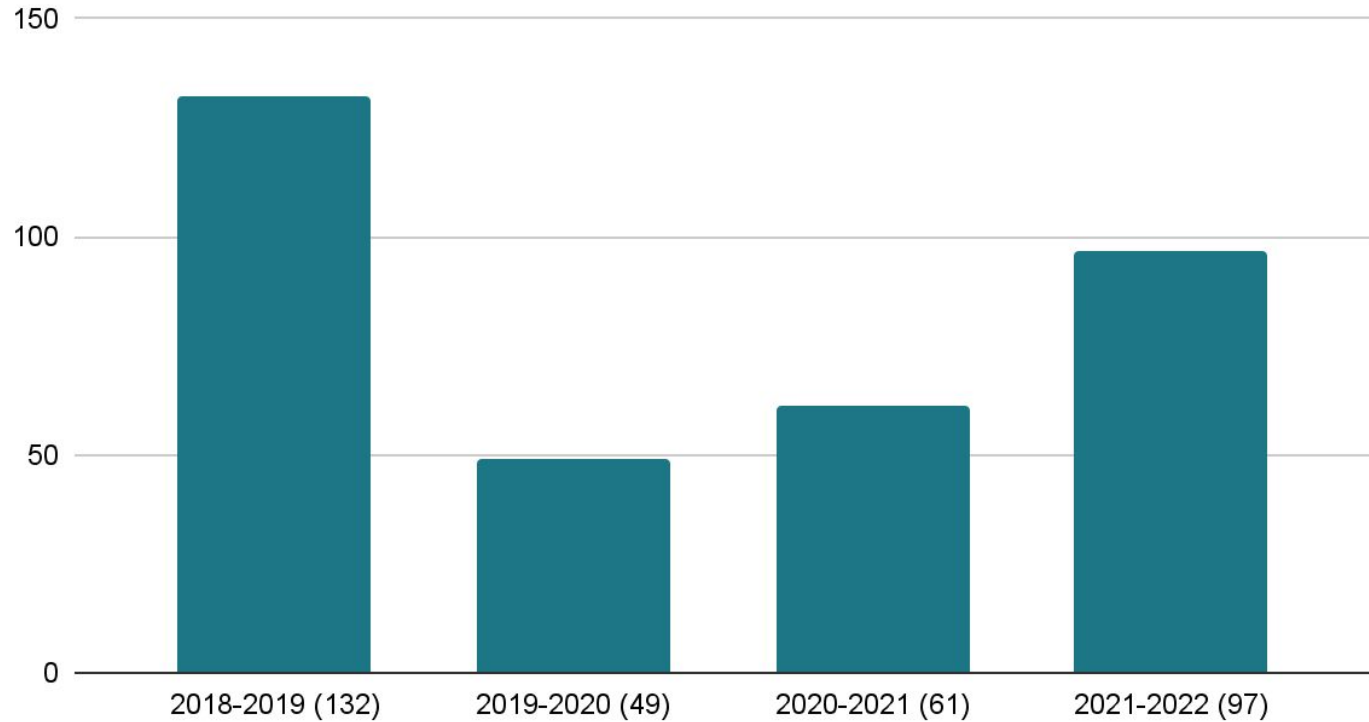


Biliteracy Achievement Award

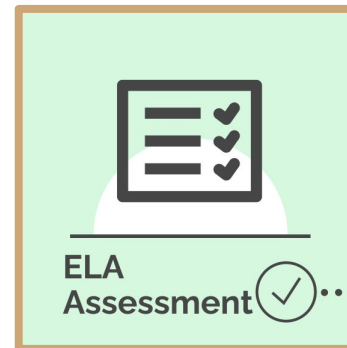
