

What is the Consolidated Application?

The Consolidated Application is also known as the ConApp. The ConApp must be submitted to the California Department of Education (CDE) for the District to receive funds for Categorical Programs. The ConApp also serves as a system for reporting program and fiscal data to CDE about the utilization of federal program funds. The application is submitted online through a web-based Consolidated Application Reporting System (CARS). The online system has two data collection reporting periods: Winter and Spring.

The ConApp Spring Report identifies the programs for which the District is requesting funding as well as the public and private, non-profit schools that plan to participate in selected federal programs. The request for funding contains assurances that federal regulations will be followed when utilizing the funds. The District requires Board approval of the Application to indicate the San Bernardino City Unified School District requests participation in federal programs.



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


