



WAYS TO EARN EXTRA TEACHING IN STPPS

Salary increases and stipends are available to current employees who are willing to transfer or move to OFAT in SWE or critical needs areas

- **\$1,000** (2 Step) salary increase for current STPPS teachers who earn new certification or teach in Special Education (SWE)
- **\$500** (1 Step) salary increase for current STPPS teachers who are not certified in a Special Education (SWE) or critical shortage area but agree to go on Out-of-Field Authorization (OFAT)
- **\$1,000** Advanced Degree Salary Increase for each advanced degree earned while working in STPPS
- **\$1,000** Annual Effectiveness Stipend
- **\$500** Annual Stipend for Teaching Critical Shortage Area (Special Education/SWE teachers and certified teachers teaching on an OFAT are not eligible for the critical shortage demand stipend) *see back of flyer for list of Critical Shortage Areas
- **\$500** Annual Stipend for Teaching at Eligible Schools *see back of flyer for list of eligible schools
- **Annual Stipend** from Employee Salary Reserve Fund if applicable
