2. That the Commission chair is directed to give notice of layoff to the affected classified employee pursuant to the requirement of law.
3. That said layoffs shall become effective the end of the day following 45 full days of notice.
4. That the employee laid off pursuant to this resolution shall be eligible for reemployment and other rights pursuant to Education Code 45298.
