

Varipilli once again represented Tomball ISD in this year's regional event following a win during the District Spelling Bee competition back in November, held at the Tomball Event Center.



Returning home and now serving as the Assistant Principal at Creekside Park Junior High, Collin Nicholas has been able to quickly make an impact on the younger generation through teaching and building relationships - two things that come so natural to him.

Nicholas grew up in Tomball and was exposed to life in the education world at a very young age with a mother who was an active volunteer on campuses throughout his childhood and who later served on the Tomball ISD Board of Trustees for over 10 years. He also had a grandfather who dedicated his career to serving children as an Elementary Principal.

"Our world needs good people who care about others, who stand up for what is right, and give back to their community, and that is what I try to model for all students and teachers that I work with," Nicholas said.

His family moved to the Tomball area shortly after he was born and he has only ever known Tomball schools. A 2007 graduate of Tomball High School, Nicholas also attended Lakewood Elementary, Tomball Intermediate, and Tomball Junior High during his K-12 experience.

"I had a really great experience at all campuses that I attended in TISD," he said. "Teachers cared about me and my success, staff were friendly and supportive, and I felt like I was prepared for college, mission trips, career, family and beyond because of what I learned in Tomball."

Nicholas played basketball all four years in high school and was a member of the National Honor Society, graduating in the Top 10% of his 2007 class. His educational success as well as being a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, led him to attend BYU.


