

Spectator Rules FFMS

1. Spectators are expected to be respectful to all opposing players, coaches, other spectators, school staff, officials, and support groups at all times.
2. The use of obscene, belligerent, or disruptive language and/or gestures in any manner to any one at any time, including taunting players, coaches, officials or other spectators by means of baiting, ridiculing, jeering, threatening physical violence or actual physical violence, and throwing any object in the spectators' viewing area, players' benches, game area, or public area is unacceptable and will result in immediate removal from the facility and may also result in further disciplinary action.
3. There is to be no smoking or drug use of any kind on school property (alcohol, tobacco, nicotine, vaping, etc.)
4. Failure to follow these expectations may result in the removal of a spectator from the premises and/or their prohibition from attending future contests.

Spectator Reminders

1. Spectators are at the contest to support and cheer for their team and to enjoy the skill and competition, not to intimidate or ridicule the other team or its fans.
2. Remember that the student-athletes competing are children and that they can hear you from the stands.
3. Understand that officials/ referees are doing their best, and admire their willingness to participate in full view of the public.

End of Game Student Pick up

- All students that attend a game as a spectator with a parent or guardian are expected to leave after the game with that parent or guardian.
- Any student that does not attend a game with their parent or guardian must contact them before the end of the game to ensure they will pick them up immediately after the game.

Spectators Viewing Areas

Football:

- Spectators can stand behind the fence on the home side and outside of the flags on the away side.

Soccer/Lax

- Spectators may stand in the middle or on the sides of the two soccer fields. Spectators may not sit near or behind the team benches. Spectators should be aware that soccer/lacrosse balls may enter the spectator area.

Basketball/ Volleyball/ Wrestling:

- Spectators may sit in the bleachers or stand on the sides of the bleachers. Spectators may not sit or stand behind the baskets or in the opposite hallways.

Baseball/ Softball

- Spectators may sit in the stands created for them.
