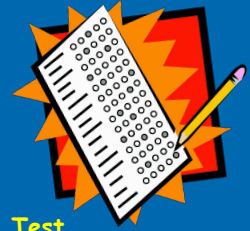

SAT, ACT & PSAT



□ SAT Scholastic Aptitude Test

- Tests critical thinking, reasoning, and problem solving
- The SAT tests a lot of vocabulary
- The highest score is 1600. Average is 1000.
- The SAT is an **aptitude** test
- Score categories:
 - Evidenced Based Reading and Writing
 - Math
 - Optional essay

□ ACT American College Test

- The ACT largely tests English grammar and punctuation.
- The highest score is 36. 19-23 is an average score
- The ACT is an **achievement** test
- Score categories:
 - English
 - Math
 - Reading
 - Science Reasoning
 - Writing optional

PSAT's—Juniors

- Preliminary SAT's
- Given as a predictor/practice exam to gauge SAT results.
