SAT Scholastic Aptitude Test

- Tests critical thinking, reasoning, and problem solving
- The SAT tests a lot of vocabulary
- The highest score is 1600. Average is 1000.
- The SAT is an aptitude test
- Score categories:
  - Evidenced Based Reading and Writing
  - Math
  - Optional essay



- The ACT largely tests English grammar and punctuation.
- The highest score is 36. 19-23 is an average score
- The ACT is an achievement test
- Score categories:
  - English
  - Math
  - Reading
  - Science Reasoning
  - Writing optional
