The Performing Arts strand focuses on the direct creation of art and entertainment by the individual artist instead of through a secondary physical medium. Performing artists are themselves the medium of creative expression. Students experience 4 years of integrated academics focused in the Arts, Media, and Entertainment industry. In addition to completing rigorous A-G courses, student performing artists will take either a 2+* or 3-4** year course sequence of classes in the same primary art field (Dance**, Instrumental Music*, Musical Theatre**, Theatre Arts**, or Vocal Music**).

Students in the Honors Program for the School of Arts must enroll in Accelerated, Honors, or AP/ Dual Enrollment Courses when available. DS students will maintain a minimum of a 3.3 academic GPA by the end of 7th Semester. (Honors Graduation Distinction).
