



Parent Involvement Opportunities 2017 - 2018

At HHES, we value our students and their families, and we believe that parental involvement in education has a significant impact on student achievement. Our plan for parent involvement emphasizes two-way home-school communication and parent participation opportunities. Listed below are some of the ways for you to be involved in your child's education while attending HHES.

Communication Opportunities

Parent – Teacher Conferences – Scheduled in the fall and spring for each child

Report Cards – Report cards are sent home at the end of each semester (January/June). Please take time to review your child's report card and contact the teacher should you have any questions.

Schoology – Sign up for an account to receive up-to-date classroom and school information.

School and classroom newsletters – Please take time to read these when they are distributed (either paper or e-mail) as they will keep you informed of what is happening at school.

District/School Website – A place to find general information you might need throughout the school year; some classrooms also have informational websites.

Back-to-School Night - Scheduled prior to the school year to meet and greet students and their families

Classroom Communication Procedures – Each teacher has a preferred method for communication (phone, e-mail, etc.). This will be shared with you by the classroom teacher in the fall.

Participation Opportunities

Classroom and/or Library Volunteer – Information will be available from your child's teacher regarding parent volunteers in the fall.

P.W.T. – Join P.W.T. (Parents Working Together) – There are many opportunities throughout the year to participate in events that support HHES.

Field Trip Chaperone – Volunteer to chaperone a classroom field trip

Attend student performances – Example: grade level music concerts, Multi-Cultural Arts Night

Attend parent education events – Examples from past years include parent literacy and/or parent math nights where parents learn strategies to support their students at home.
