Semester 2 Student Schedules

We are currently in the process of finalizing student schedules for semester 2. At this time, schedules are still being adjusted. Your student will receive a copy of their finalized semester 2 schedule in Homebase the week of January 23.

When we create student schedules, there are many factors we must consider. These include student forecasting, class size, balance of students, and the availability of courses in our master schedule. Creating schedules for nearly 500 learners is a complex process. We have made every effort to create student schedules that honor our student's preferences from their forecasting.

Because of the complex nature of scheduling, we are unable to accommodate requests for schedule changes except in the following circumstances:

- · Student is missing a core class or graduation requirement
- Student is registered for duplicate classes
- Student does not meet the prerequisite requirements for the course (e.g. placed into French 2, without having taken French 1)

- Current sports physical uploaded to Registration (physician signature required) <u>click here for form</u>
- Proof of medical insurance-Insurance may be purchased here
- Scholastic and WIAA eligibility (see athletic handbook- read current handbook and sign on Family ID)
- Sport Fee and ASB Paid (For cut sports- wait to make payment until team selections)
- All past due fines must be paid to participate
- Pay for your participation fee or outstanding fees by <u>clicking</u> <u>here</u>

Registration is open until December 14. Students must have completed paperwork by this date in order to try out. Tryouts will be held the week of Jan. 3-6.
