# **Note from the Principals**

**HHES Families:** 

With snowy weather in the forecast, we wanted to share with you some information about plans for inclement weather.

**Late Start:** If a late start is announced by the school district, AM classes will not attend in-person learning on that day. At 10 AM, morning classes will have a class Zoom with their teacher and get assignments for the day. PM classes will continue as scheduled.

Remote and HVA classes will operate on their regular schedule, even on late start days.

Specialist Zooms (art, music, and PE) will continue on their regular schedule, even on late start days.

**Snow Days:** If the district announces a snow day, we will not have classes in person or remotely. The HSD is prepared to cancel school on two days and extend the end of the school year through June 18 before shifting to a remote learning model on additional inclement weather days.

#### **Parent-Teacher Conferences**

Spring parent teacher conferences are quickly approaching. We are excited to share with you the progress your student is making in school. For your planning purposes, here is some additional information about what conference week will look like for students and families.

Monday, March 29 and Tuesday, March 30, AM students will attend class at their regular time (8 - 10:30 a.m) and PM students will not attend class. Thursday, April 1 and Friday, April 2, PM students will attend class at their regular time (12-2:30 p.m.) and AM students will not attend class.

Conferences will be held on the afternoons of March 29 and 30, the morning of April 1 and 2, and during the day on Wednesday, March 31. Teachers will reach out to you to schedule a conference day and time.

Parent-teacher conferences will be held remotely, via Zoom for safety reasons.

Picture Day will be held on Friday, March 5. If your child attends school in-person, they will have their picture taken during their scheduled in-person time. If your child attends school remotely or through HVA, you can stop by between 10:45 - 11:45 a.m. or call the office to schedule a time to visit school for pictures.

- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea
