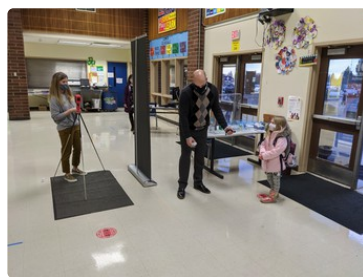

School Safety Update

Parents: To ensure a smooth drop process, please be sure that your students is ready to exit the car when you pull up the curb outside of the commons. If you are dropping off your child at HHES and will exit the car, please be sure to wear a mask. Thanks for helping us model safe behavior on campus. If you are picking up your child from school, please hang your car tag from your rearview window. New tags were sent home with your child this week (the numbers are the same as last year). If you need a new car tag, please call the office.

Each day HHES students attending in-person learning complete a health screening at school. This health screening is conducted by our school nurse and / or health staff. The screening entails a temperature check and health questions (such as, How are you feeling today?).
