ORIENTATION EVENTS

Hornet Academy - 6th grade (Monday)

Please plan to drop your student off some time between 7:45 and 8:00 a.m. Students will pick up their class schedules when they arrive. Students will then run through a shortened version of their school schedule so that they get some practice moving between classes. In each class, students will complete a different orientation activity such as checking out their school

Chromebook, picking up their spirit wear t-shirt, and taking a school tour. Students will enjoy a lunch break in the cafeteria as well (We will provide a small snack). Students will finish the day with our school leadership team and have a brief pep assembly.

Parents are welcome to join us at HMS from 11 - 12. We will hold a class on how to access Schoology in our computer lab from 11:00 - 11:30 and again from 11:30 - 12. Parents can also stop by the office to make payments for ASB cards and yearbooks, and stop by our PWT table to learn about volunteering for school events or to make a PWT donation.

Students can be picked up in the front driveway at 12 p.m.

7th and 8th Grade Orientation (Tuesday)

Orientation for our 7th and 8th graders will be held on Tuesday between 8 a.m. and 12 p.m. This is a drop-in event and your family can come at whatever time works best for you. Students will pick up their schedules, get their photo taken and ID card printed, and check out their Chromebook.

SKIP THE LINE AT ORIENTATION

All students <u>must</u> have a Chromebook Assurance form completed online prior to checking out a Chromebook. You can opt to purchase Assurance protection or decline coverage online. You can also purchase a yearbook and ASB card online and avoid the line at Orientation. STUDENT SCHEDULES

Student schedules will be distributed at Orientation on Monday (sixth grade) and Tuesday (seventh and eighth grades). All schedules will also be available on Skyward Family Access on Tuesday morning.

Student schedules are created based on the forecasting information submitted by students at the end of the prior school year. Class placements are considered final. Schedule changes will only be made if:

- 1. the student is missing a class (i.e. has no English Language Arts class)
- 2. the student has duplicate classes (i.e. two period of math)
- 3. The student is missing a prerequisite class (i.e. is placed in French 2 without having taken French 1)

THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

On the first day of school, students will be welcomed to campus by our student leaders. All students will have a modified schedule so that they spend one hour in their Home Base class. HomeBase teachers will lead a school tour, explain safety protocols, and get to know the students. Students will then continue with their regular class schedule for 35 minute periods. All sixth grade students, will have student leaders escort them to the bus of parent pick up area at the end of the day. Just a reminder, the first day of school is a one-hour early release and students will be dismissed at 2:20 p.m.
