HMS FALL PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

The staff of HMS is looking forward to seeing you at our upcoming parent-teacher conferences. We will be using the <u>three-hour early dismissal schedule</u> for the entire week of October 24 - 28, 2022.

Fall arena conferences are being held during the day, Monday October 24 through Thursday, October 27th from 1:40 p.m. -3:40 p.m. Evening arena conferences will be available on Monday, October 24th from 6 p.m. - 7:40 p.m. Families who are unable to attend a conference during the day, can attend on Monday evening. *Please note that Monday evening conferences tend to be the busiest and it may not be possible to visit with every teacher.*

For all conferences, please bring your student with you as they are an important part of the conversation.

Parents are invited to attend arena conferences on their scheduled day:

Monday October 24: Families with last names A - I Tuesday, October 25: Families with last names J - R Wednesday, October 26: Families with last names S - Z Thursday, October 27: Any family unable to attend on their scheduled day

Arena conferences are limited to a few minutes and will be held in the HMS gym. Because our teachers see around 140 students per day, it may not be possible for every parent to meet with every teacher. Parents will be able to select which teacher or teachers they'd like to meet and can wait until that teacher becomes available. This process gives the greatest number of parents the chance to meet and have a short discussion with the teachers.


