A Note from the Principal

HMS Families:

Thank you to the HMS families who completed our recent parent survey. We greatly appreciate your feedback on what is working well and where we can improve as a school community. We take your thoughts and opinions seriously and have used your feedback to help us to plan for the coming semester. Below, I have summarized some key findings from our survey and our HMS response to the concerns that were shared. We are hopeful that the changes we have planned will help to make your family's experience at HMS even better in the coming term.

Our survey shows that most HMS families feel that their children have positive relationships with their teachers, are happy with their child's academic experience, and feel that school communication, safety, and school logistics meet their needs. Our parent survey indicated three areas of concern: parent-teacher communication, feedback on academic progress, and safety concerns regarding masks and vaccinations. Our plans to address these concerns are:

Parent-Teacher Communication

It is our goal to build and foster positive working relationships with families to support student learning. An important part of building these relationships is frequent, timely, and informative parent-teacher communication, and we are committed to improving in this area. To help bolster our parent-teacher relationships, teachers will respond to all email and phone communications within 1 business day. We also heard from families that parent-teacher conferences are an important way for families to connect to school. Our spring parent-teacher conferences will be reformatted and offer every family a chance to schedule time to speak with their child's teachers.


Feedback on Academic Performance

We heard from families that in order to support their child at home, they need more information on their child's progress in their classes. Our staff will ensure that Schoology grading is updated on a weekly basis so that parents have timely information on their child's academic information. We will also provide more detailed information about your child's progress by sending out progress reports every 6 weeks. These progress reports will show grades for all classes.

Many families stated that they feel that HSD needs to do more to ensure mask-wearing and vaccinations. Many others shared that they would like HSD not to have mask wearing and do not agree with vaccinations. We know that this is an area in which many families have strong feelings and opinions. We thank you for sharing your perspectives with us. HSD and HMS follow policies created by the Washington Department of Health and Clark County Health Department. As a school, we do not have the authority to change these policies. We will continue to keep families updated on any changes to the DOH and CCPH guidelines.

Again, we'd like to thank you for sharing your feedback with us. Parents and families are the backbone of our community and we value your thoughts on how we can improve the HMS experience. Thank you for your ongoing support of the students and staff of HMS! We are all grateful to be a part of this amazing community!

If you are a teacher already, we are very interested in talking to you about getting your application reviewed as quickly as possible. If you hold a Bachelor's Degree and are interested in obtaining an Emergency Substitute Certificate to cover teachers please email Julie.dobbins@hocksd.org. There is a process we can enter into with the state that takes a little bit of time, but it would allow you to serve as a teacher.

Not interested in being a teacher, but want to help? We have a significant need for classified substitutes as well. These subs cover our general duty aides at recess/lunch, para-educators in classrooms, secretaries, security, and custodial staff. Basic requirement is a high school diploma or GED.

Emergency Certificated Substitute Teachers: \$163.00/day \$101.00 half day

Classified Substitute (Various/non-custodial): \$16.00/hour Custodial Substitutes: \$18.00/hour

To begin the application process please visit our website www.hocksd.org and click on the employment icon. This will take you to a module in our system called "Fast Track". Here you will create a user profile and apply for the appropriate position. If you are applying for "Emergency Cert Sub" please apply for the certificated substitute. It will require you to upload a certificate – here you can override by uploading a letter simply stating "I wish to apply for Emergency Cert Sub".
