FOOD DRIVE

Our Hockinson Middle School Food Drive kicks off next week! We are excited to help our community by collecting donation of nutritious, non-perishable food items. Our food drive will run from Friday, Nov. 19 through Thursday, Dec. 16. On Friday, Dec. 17, the students from the HomeBase class who has brought in the most food will help deliver the food items to the Fire District 3 where they will be distributed to families in need.

In 2019, HMS brought in over 5,000 food items for local families and we are hoping to do even better this year!

There will be a friendly school-wide competition for HomeBase classes during the Food Drive. There are three categories for the HomeBase competition: HomeBase Food Drive Points, Grade Level Total Items, and HomeBase Total Donation.

Points Competition

All non-perishable food items donated are worth one point. There are special bonus items that can be turned in for additional points on special Bonus Days.

Bonus Point Food

Pasta and/or Pasta Sauce, Mac & Cheese, Rice (no ramen, no sauce packets or mixes, no single serving pasta meals/chef-boy-r-dee) "CARB DAY"

Friday, Nov. 19, 2 points

Stove Top Stuffing (only STOVE TOP brand)

Tuesday, Nov. 23, 2 points

Chili, Boxed Cornbread Mix, Canned Beans, Dry Beans

Tuesday, Nov. 30, 3 points

Pancake Mix and Syrups and Cereals

Friday, Dec. 3, 3 points

Canned Meat (tuna, shrimp, spam, clams, chicken, etc.), Crackers

Tuesday, Dec. 7, 3 points

Condiments, Salad Dressings, (usually these are in bottles or jars, no packets)

Friday, Dec. 10, 4 points

Cooking Oils

Tuesday, Dec. 14, 4 points

Peanut Butter and/or Jellies, Potatoes (5lb or 10lb unopened bags of potatoes, no single potatoes, peanut butter substitutes such as nutella will be accepted)

Thursday, Dec. 16, 4 points

There are also three Combo Points Days. On these days, 2 extra points will be earned for each combo pair (above and beyond bonus points).

Food Drive Combo Dates

Day 1 - Friday, Nov. 19th

Pasta and Pasta Sauce

Day 4 - Friday, Dec, 3rd

Pancake Mix and Syrup

Day 8 - Thursday, Dec. 16th

Peanut Butter and Jelly

Double Points will be awarded to each HomeBase class that has at least 10 regular food items in their basket on any pick up day (Tuesdays and Fridays).

Bombs (negative points)

All Campbells Soup products are affectionately known as 'bombs'. These will count for negative points and can be placed in the basket of any HomeBase class during the first 5 minutes of HomeBase. Products less than 20 ounces will count for two negative points. Products greater than 20 ounces will count as four negative points.
