## Required Documents

Please have the following required documents ready to submit or upload for each student during the enrollment process. **Additional documentation may be required for certain grade levels.** Accepted forms of proof as well as immunization requirements are available in the tables below. ## Additional Documents

- Home Language Survey

*California Education Code, Sections 313 and 60810 contain legal requirements which direct schools to determine the language(s) spoken in the home of each student. **This survey must be obtained and completed in person at the school site.***

## Accepted Forms of Documentation

Proof of age and proof of residence within the district are required for all enrolling students. Please see the table below for accepted forms of documentation.

Requirement	Accepted Forms of Documentation
<b>Proof of age</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Certified copy of a birth record</li> <li>Statement by the local registrar or county recorder certifying date of birth</li> <li>Baptism certificate duly attested</li> <li>Passport</li> </ul>
<b>Proof of residence</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rental or lease agreement currently or recently signed in parent/guardian's name</li> <li>Current PG&amp;E or utility bill in the parent/guardian's name</li> <li>Property tax receipts for the current residence</li> <li>Mortgage statements in parent/guardian's name</li> </ul>

## Required Immunizations

Lodi USD adheres to the California Department of Public Health immunization requirements for all student enrollments. Required immunizations are shown in the table below. For detailed information, scan the QR code or see [Shots Required for TK-12th Grade \(shotsforschool.org\)](#).

Immunization	Dosage	Notes
<b>Polio</b> (OPV or IPV)	4 doses	Three doses OK if at least one was given on or after 4th birthday.
<b>Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis</b> (DTaP, DTP, Tdap, or Td)	5 doses	Four doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday (visit <a href="#">CDPH website</a> for more information).
<b>Measles, Mumps, Rubella</b> (MMR)	2 doses	Both doses given on or after the child's 1st birthday.
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	3 doses	Second dose given 4 weeks after first dose. Third dose given as early as 8 weeks after second dose.
<b>Varicella</b> (Chickenpox)	2 doses	For ages 12 and under, second dose given 3 months after first dose. For ages 13 and up, second dose given 4 weeks after first dose.
