



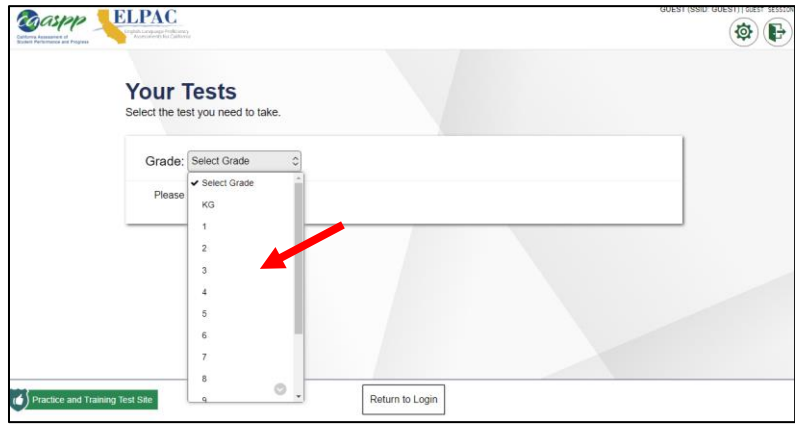


Instructions on how students and parents can go through a practice/training test, from home, using a district assigned device

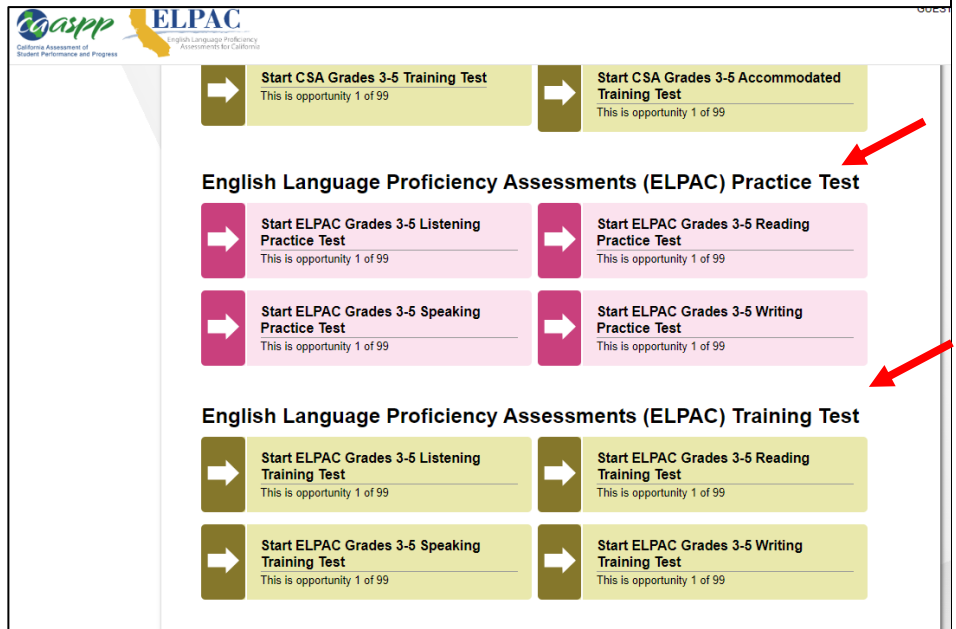
<p>1. Find and click on the <i>Secure test App</i> on your district assigned iPad.</p> <p>Students should have the <i>Secure Test App</i> loaded onto their school assigned device and will need access to an internet connection.</p>	
<p>NOTE: Some students may not need to go through this step. If that is the case, skip this step.</p> <p>2. From the first drop down, select <i>California</i> and from the second select <i>California Assessment System</i> and click <i>OK</i>.</p>	
<p>3. Click the <i>Go to the practice and Training Test Site</i> (white box on the left-hand side of the page).</p>	
<p>4. Student will need to toggle <i>Guest User ON</i> (blue) and <i>Guest session ON</i> (blue).</p>	

5. From the drop-down menu, *select the appropriate grade.*

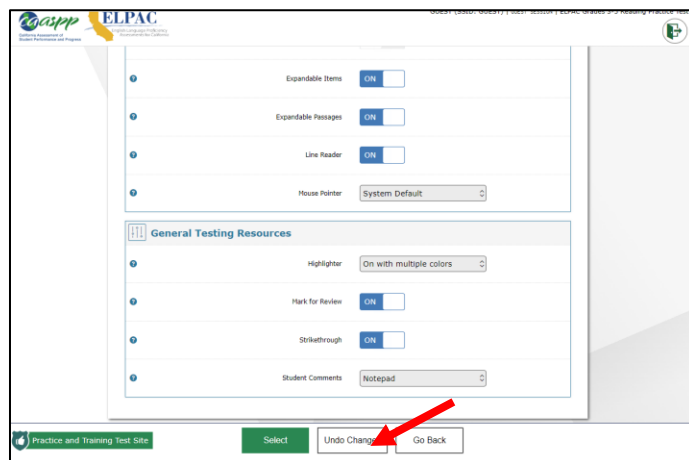


6. From the menu, select either the *ELPAC Practice Test or Training Test.*

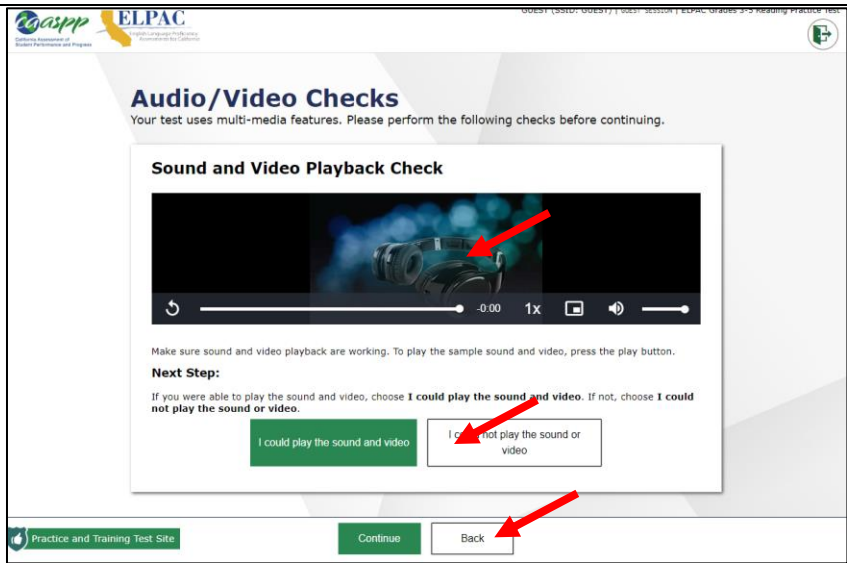
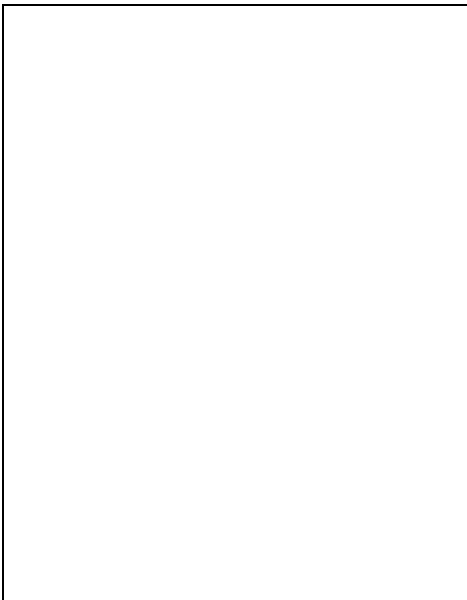
The ELPAC is split into 4 domains. Students are required to complete all 4 domains for the Summative ELPAC testing window.



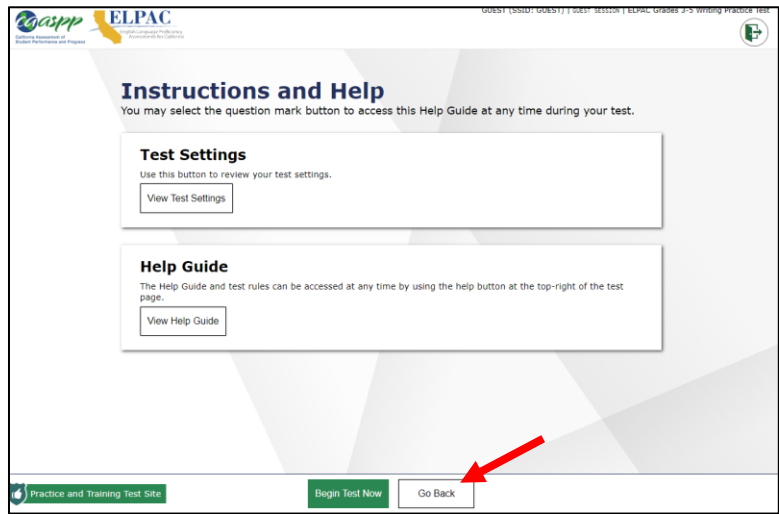
7. Scroll to the bottom of the window and click on *Select.*



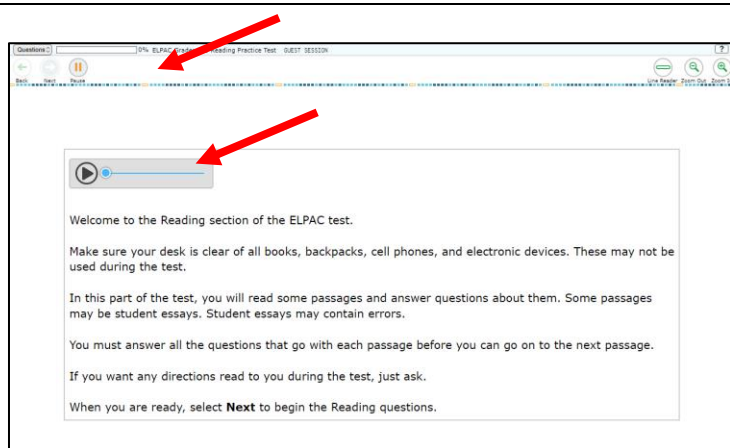
8. Go through the student checks.



9. Click on *begin test*.



10. Play the audio track and go through the practice and training test questions by clicking on the 'Next' button.



11. Once you've completed the domain, go through steps 4-8 to take a different domain. Students are required to take a listening, speaking, reading and writing test during the summative testing window. Please refer back to the DFA for instructions.
