Hello Parents and Students!!

I hope that you everyone has an amazing April! We are working on State testing this month. Students are required to take the M-STEP, PSAT, SAT, and/or ACT WorkKeys based on their grade level. At WAY Michigan we offer Khan Academy for students to participate in to build their test taking skills throughout the school year. Below is a brief description of the programs:

1. Khan Academy- This website provides a free test preparation course. The WAY Michigan class code is USWBZDJ2. The activities are individualized to help improve reading, writing, and math skills. Students can connect their College Board account or take a diagnostic test to evaluate their current skill level. This program offers up to 8 full-length practice tests.

In addition, we are working with our seniors to complete their graduation requirements. We have a deadline of May 12th for Cap and Gown orders.
