Welcome to International School Bangkok.

Student Safeguarding is a priority at ISB. For this reason, ISB has developed and adopted a Student Safeguarding Policy and Code of Conduct for ISB Staff, Associates, Visitors, and Parents.

ISB values parents and the school's partnership to promote our students' learning and protect our community's safety. While we welcome parents/guardians on our campus, we maintain guidelines and structures that prioritize student learning and safety.

ISB requires that all Parents visiting our campus:

- On-Campus
 - Have lanyards on and ISB picture ID visible at all times to identify you as part of the community.
 - Only use designated adult toilets and changing rooms.
 - Avoid physical contact with students.
 - Remain in the common public areas during regular school hours. You are welcome in the learning spaces when invited or participating in a school-sponsored event.
- Digitally
 - Please only take photos/videos of your child. Only images of your child should be posted online.
 - Practice polite and respectful digital communications. Social media and social chat groups are a valuable and powerful tool for communication. We ask that you follow communication channels if you have questions or concerns about your child's learning or the school.
- Serve as an adult role model for all students. You must follow all school guidelines and policies (including, but not limited to, our harassment policy, drug and alcohol policy, confidentiality policy, and non-discrimination policy).
- Conduct yourself in a manner aligned with the ISB values.

Everyone entering ISB needs to be aware that CCTV is in operation at all times on our campus.

There are times when parents will be acting in a temporary supervisory role or in a position within the school where they will be in direct contact with students. At these times, it's important to remember they represent ISB and are expected to follow the guidelines, policies, and procedures as outlined by the school.

It is expected that you will treat all students in a caring and respectful manner. If you have a relationship with a student outside of school as a parent, it is important to understand that the ISB role you are acting in is the priority. Any concerns or issues should be reported to an ISB employee immediately.

All of us at ISB want you to know that we genuinely value our Parents on campus, and we ask for and appreciate your support in providing the safest environment for our students.
