Update on Old Kerr Elementary School

This past Thursday the OLD Kerr Elementary school was cleared of any asbestos by the Allegheny County Health Department. **This is great news!** The demolition work will now resume on Friday, September 5, 2019, and will take 20 workdays or less to complete.

Open House @ Kerr Is CANCELLED

Our Kerr Elementary School Open House scheduled for October 17th from 6-8 p.m. has been cancelled. The cancellation is due to the lack of parking space that is available on school premises. This cancellation is with disappointment because our open house has traditionally been a very successful event where our Kerr Elementary School community and staff are able to visit with each other in an informal and enjoyable environment. I am looking forward to our next open house and setting a new standard for our school community moving forward.

Recess

As we await our new recess area to be built within the upcoming months, we have put things into place that will allow students to have physical activity throughout the school day while maintaining the integrity of the academic schedule. Outdoor recess is currently being held outside on our bus loop area. We have an assortment of appropriate recess provisions (footballs, balls, corn hole, hula hoops, etc.) that work well within the space of our outdoor area. Indoor recess activities are inclusive to the individual

choices of our students. Based on the grade level, indoor recess provides various physical activities, such as: Corn Hole, BucketBall, Giant Toppling Tower, Ring Toss, Giant Dice games, BulziBucket, etc. During assigned days, grade levels will have the opportunity to have indoor recess in the gym based on the weekly schedule. Many students still like to read, draw, play board games, and sit and talk with friends during recess, so these options are also available for all students as well. Students in the intermediate grade levels are able to move to other grade level classrooms where specific activities have been designated for a particular day.



During the school day, each grade level has incorporated a movement break so that all students experience some type of activity during the academic portion of their day. Also, students in grades 1-5



have physical education twice a week built into the regularly scheduled week.

We appreciate your patience as we put things into place for this school year. We will continue to work within the parameters of our school building and the academic schedule to ensure that physical activity is included at multiple times within a school day.
