



MILLFIELD

Millfield fees are as inclusive as possible and extras are kept to a minimum. The day fee includes tuition, most activities at school, three-course lunch, supper for pupils staying for activities, games and prep, pupils' personal accident insurance, contribution to travel and accommodation when representing the school, and internet access. The boarding fee includes all of the above plus breakfast, three-course supper and laundry.

Extra Charges

So far as possible other 'extras' are kept to a minimum, but may include:

Public/External Examinations	Costs vary by chosen subjects and level undertaken.
BTEC Registration fees	Charged in advance at point of registering for the course (Level 2 approx. £75; Level 3 approx. £200 depending on course). Resits charged in addition. Further details from Exams Office.
Art, Design & Technology	Charges may be made for material, stationery and project work.
Textbooks	Charges are made for Sixth Form textbooks which should be retained for personal use. Other year groups mainly use online resources, but textbooks may be loaned for certain subjects and charges will be made where these are lost, damaged or not returned.
Residential Field Trips	Contribution to the costs.
Sports	Personal membership, entry fees, equipment/kit, accommodation and travel to external National Governing Body ("NGB") pathway activity, clubs and professional sport academies.

Optional Charges

Shop and Travel	Expenses incurred are provided on termly statements.
House/School Trips, Dry Cleaning	Actual costs incurred.
Photographs	House, group, sports and year photos as ordered.
Private Tuition (Academic/Sports)	Hourly rate is charged dependent on tutor's pay.
Physiotherapy	Initial session £68 and follow-up sessions £65.
Combined Cadet Force (CCF)	One off joiner's fee £80.

Admission Fees (new applicants only)

Registration Fee	£200 (non-refundable)
Acceptance Fee	£1560 (£260 non-refundable, £1300 credited on final extras bill)

For those pupils who do not take up their place, Millfield will retain the whole Acceptance Fee.

Child Student Visa

Applicants	£450 (£425 administration charge and £25 UKVI visa fee non-refundable)
Renewal	£250 (£225 administration charge and £25 UKVI visa fee non-refundable)

Additional Deposit (applicable to non-UK residents only)

For administration reasons, an additional deposit equal to one term's fees is payable with the acceptance fee. This deposit will be credited to the final payment of fees or other sums due to the school on leaving.

Payment of fees

The fees are payable for the full academic year and are expressed and collected in three termly amounts. All fees outlined in this fee notice are exclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT), unless explicitly stated otherwise. Any applicable VAT will be charged in addition to the specified fees at the prevailing rate as mandated by tax regulations. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the payment of VAT on the fees for their child(ren)'s education. The school will issue VAT invoices in compliance with applicable tax laws. In the event of any changes to the VAT rate or legislation during the academic year covered by this fee notice, the school reserves the right to adjust the fees accordingly, with due notice provided to parents/guardians.

Fees are payable by Direct Debit from a UK bank account by the first day of each term, unless a prior agreement has been made with the Fees Manager. If you do not have a UK bank account, international payments may be made via [Flywire](#).

A late payment charge will be applied to any outstanding amounts on a daily basis after the due date. Child Care Vouchers can be accepted for the boarding part of the fees, subject to HMRC rules.

Fees in Advance

The school operates a fees in advance scheme which offers a discount for fees paid in advance for future terms. Further details are available from the Fees Office.

Notice

One full term's written notice from parents to the Head is required on withdrawal of a pupil and on transfer from boarding to day status. Those failing to do this will be charged one term's fees in lieu of notice. A term's written notice is also required for Music and Riding or a term's fees for extra tuition will be charged.
