PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

(FOR REVIEW OF STUDENT RECORDS)

The principal of each Volusia County School Schools shall provide the parent or guardian of pupils currently enrolled, an annual written notification of their rights of access to review pupil records.

The department of student services shall update and provide a copy of the notification to each principal annually.

The following persons have access to student records: Board members, Superintendent and staff, professional staff of the school, Records Management Department staff, clerical and secretarial staff designated by the principal, the parent/legal guardian of the student, an eligible student, and other persons authorized in writing by the parent/legal guardian or eligible student except in cases where other professionals have legitimate educational or legal interest in student records as specified in the student record procedures.

In cases where a parent/legal guardian does not have custody, the school principal shall presume that the parent/legal guardian has the right to inspect and review the records of the student unless the school has been provided with evidence that there is a legally binding instrument or court order which provides to the contrary.
