Reports

Principal

- School Improvement plan helps us set our 3-year goal. We also set benchmark goals for each of the years to help meet the 3-year goal.
- We reviewed the PowerPoint on pathway indicators. With school demographics it is important to remember some of the subgroups, like race or low income can be a very small percentage of students.
- We need to come up with a goal for numeracy, literacy, culture/climate and gap goal.
- Our tentative achievement gap goal we will reduce the achievement gap in math growth scores and in reading proficiency scores between students with disabilities, (SWD) and general education students by June of 2026 with a minimum of 9% from the 2022 levels as measured by the Acadience Reading and Math assessments and the Reading Inventory assessment.
- Our tentative literacy goal is for 89% of K-3 students at Uintah Elementary to be proficient on the End-of-Year Acadience Reading Assessment and for 88% of our 4-6 students to be proficient on the End-of-year Reading Inventory (RI) assessment by June of 2026.
- For our tentative numeracy goal is to have 80% of our K-3 students and 4-6 students to be proficient on the End-of-year Acadience Math Assessment by June of 2026.
- With our tentative culture goal we will have 90% of K-6 students able to name the Zones of Regulation and will be able to describe at least 2 strategies in each zone which the student can use or has used to help them regulate in that zone by June of 2026.

- Trust lands funds will be used to keep supporting kids with Ms. Gustafson and any remaining money for paras to continue helping our students.
- TSSA money is used and will continue to be used to help with our paras and to help fund the zones of regulation.
- We will vote on a plan for funding at the next SCC meeting, April 13.
- Brian Conley will attend the next meeting for boundary realignment.
