

Parent and Student Rights in Administration of Surveys, Analysis or Evaluation

Right to Inspect

Parents, upon request, will have the opportunity to inspect the following:

- A. Surveys created by a third party before the survey is administered or distributed by a school to students:
- B. Instructional material used as part of the educational curriculum; and
- C. Any survey document used to collect information from students.

Opt-Out

Parents and adult or emancipated minor students have the ability to opt their children or themselves out of participating in the following activities:

- A. Any survey that reveals information described in Policy 3232;
- B. Activities involving collection, disclosure, or use of personal information obtained from students for marketing or selling to others; or
- C. Any non-emergency, invasive physical examination or screening required as a condition of attendance, administered by the school, and not necessary to protect the health and safety of a student.

Notice

Prior to the administration of any survey, analysis or evaluation described above, the district will provide prior notice that the activity will occur. The district will communicate methods by which students may be opted out.
