Review minutes from last meeting

- Ms. Thompson shared her gratitude to the teaching staff and NDJH and how hard they work with students. She has been impressed with all that they do.
- Kids are also doing a great job taking care of each other which has been nice to see

Look at Data requested from last time

- a. ELL Data
 - i. Ms. Thompson shared efforts that have been made to help ELL students
 - ii. New program: **Elevation** allows for the school to be able to see much more detailed information
 1. Provides teaching resources for ELL strategies
 2. Provides professional learning helps
 3. Will be introduced to faculty in after January
 - iii. Trustlands goal: ELL proficiency to 50% at adequate progress
 1. Last year was at 51%
 2. Ms. Thompson shared her desire to increase that score
- b. 9th grade on track data

- i. Ms. Nielsen explained the jump in Off track students due to the new program but total on track after remediation was 87% which is the same or higher than previous years
- ii. Questions about how to help students earn credit when off track during the year when they withdraw from NDJH
- iii. Committee discussed the need to make a more realistic goal for the % goal of students on track (current goal is 95%)
- iv. Discussion about helping improve student mindset

Title I Information

- Ms. Thompson gave clarification of the Title I program and why/how NDJH qualifies
- Clarification that it is a FUNDING source and not a program
- 10th year of funding for NDJH. Funds have gone down every year.
