

8th grade Transfer Students

Upon Registration

Enroll student in required courses. Students will be required to participate in designated activities related to the course:

English To include Business Letter

Math Based upon transcript and MAP score, register student for appropriate course: (Pre-Integrated Math or Integrated Algebra/Geometry I)

U.S. History To include US History ALT and Education/Career Plan

Science To include Science Inquiry/Technical Writing

Technology To include Keyboarding, Database, Spreadsheet

Use transcripts to waive competency requirements. Use MAP results and transcripts to enroll students in appropriate course(s) and intervention opportunity(ies):

- Communication – The 7th grade narrative is waived with a score of 12 or greater on the 8th grade state analytic writing assessment (CRT).
- Foreign Language – If the student speaks a native language other than English (as documented in *PowerSchool* with a Language Code other than “1”), the Oral Proficiency Exam may be waived. Students with prior foreign language experience may challenge the Oral Proficiency Exam immediately. Other students may choose to enroll in a foreign language elective.
- Technology – If the student has earned ½ credit of Computer Literacy with a “C” or better from a Nevada or Alpine County middle school, waive the credit requirement and related competencies.

Schedule the students for next testing administration of MAP.

- Science
- Reading
- Language
- Math

If grades from 7th and 8th grade cannot be verified through an accredited transcript, then the student should be enrolled in an appropriate intervention opportunity.

Students enrolling in the 4th quarter of a school year will be considered transfer students under the next grade’s requirements.
