

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION

No. 518(d)

Board of Trustees Douglas County School District

STUDENTS

TRANSFER STUDENTS, GRADES 7 - 12

All students receiving a diploma from the Douglas County School District must successfully meet the [requirements of graduation](#) established by this Board and approved by the State Board of Education.

It is the District's policy that students transferring from a district that is not a competency-based system be individually assessed and required to demonstrate competency in the basic skill areas as appropriate based on their prior educational experience and the time available until their expected graduation.

Upon registration in a secondary school of Douglas County School District, the transfer student will meet with a school counselor to be assessed and to have his/her educational records analyzed. District guidelines appropriate to the student's grade level will be followed in order to waive competency requirements or enroll students in appropriate courses and/or intervention opportunities.

Students previously attending Douglas County School District will be held responsible for demonstrating competency in the basic skill areas up to the point of their withdrawal from the district. Upon re-enrollment, district transfer guides will be utilized to determine competency requirements for their period of attendance outside the District.
