STUDENTS

COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAM (CREDIT)

- 1. The high school principal must annually approve all community service programs (agencies).
- 2. Students must obtain approval from the school principal prior to participating in a community service program.
- 3. One-half elective graduation credit will be awarded to students successfully completing 100 hours of community service in an approved program.
- 4. A maximum of one graduation credit can be earned by students in the community service program.
- 5. Hours may be carried over from year to year to enable students to accumulate hours necessary for credit.
- 6. Students may not be excused from attending the regular school program and related requirements to participate in a community service program.
- 7. On a nine-weeks basis, participating agencies must forward to the school principal a complete listing including:
 - a) Name of student.
 - b) Total hours accumulated.
 - c) Rating of student performance (satisfactory or unsatisfactory).
 - d) Signature of agency person responsible for community service program.
