## SANITARY MANAGEMENT

The Board recognizes that the health and physical well-being of the students of this District depends in large measure upon the cleanliness and sanitary management of the schools.

The Board directs that a program of sanitary management be instituted in the schools and explained annually to all employees. Each school shall be inspected for cleanliness and sanitation at least annually. The drinking water in each school shall be tested by the purveyor of the supply and in accordance with any State grants or initiatives.

The Superintendent shall develop and supervise a program for the cleanliness and sanitary management of the school buildings, school grounds and school equipment. Cleanliness in each school building shall be the responsibility of the head custodian, under the supervision of his supervisor and the principal.
