OPERATIONS

FOOD SERVICES

The Board recognizes the midday meal as an important part of each school child's day. The Board may, therefore, provide cafeteria facilities in all the schools of this District for the purchase and consumption of lunch and snacks. Unless they have been excused by the principal or the school has been designated an open campus, all students are expected to remain at school for lunch.

The operation and supervision of the food services program shall be the responsibility of the Food Services Supervisor, reporting to the Executive Director of Human Resources. The cafeterias shall be operated on a nonprofit basis. A periodic review of the cafeteria accounts shall be made by the District Auditor. Surplus funds shall be used to reduce the cost of the service to the pupils served and/or to purchase needed equipment.

The District may participate in the Federal School Lunch Program.
